

D.I.Y Fish Trap.

You will need:

An adult to help!

Tape, scissors (or knife), string, a plastic bottle, old bread.



Step 1: Cut the top of the bottle using either the knife...



...or scissors. You may need an adult to help with this!



2. Invert the top of the bottle,



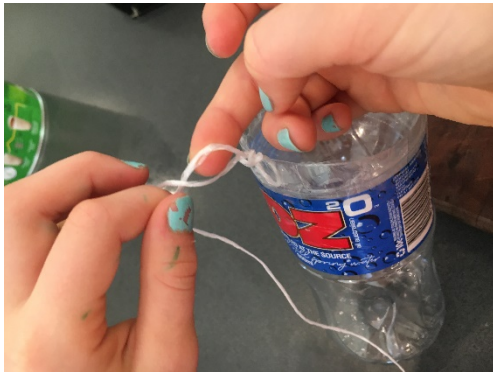
Secure it with the sticky tape. All the way around the top.



3. Using your scissors or knife, make a hole and thread some string through.



4. Drop a piece of bread into your trap for bait!



5. Make a small hole at the base, to let the air bubbles escape when you put it in the water. We forgot to do this step; it still works but just takes a little more effort to get the trap to sink!

6. Hold on to the string, fill the bottle with the dam/river/lake water and then gently toss your trap into the water.

7. Secure your string, so you don't lose your trap.

8. Leave your trap for a little while. When you think enough time has passed, come back and see if you have caught anything! Be patient, it may take a few times before you catch anything! Keep trying 😊

While you fish and prepare your trap, think about the story, and how you might have felt if you were in Peter's shoes (OK, Peter wasn't wearing shoes, but you know what I mean! 😊).

You know what else? Jesus didn't give up on Peter, just like he will never give up on you!
